

THE PROCEDURE FOR PROCESSING DOCUMENTS FOR OBTAINING A VISA

FOR FULL INFORMATION ABOUT THE VISA PROCEDURE, PLEASE CONTACT THE EMBASSY OF BELARUS IN YOUR COUNTRY, AS THE RULES FOR OBTAINING A VISA AND THE DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR OBTAINING A VISA AT EACH EMBASSY ARE DIFFERENT, AS WELL AS THE RULES FOR OBTAINING A VISA OFTEN CHANGE AND DEPEND ON THE REGION OF RESIDENCE OF EACH CANDIDATE.

How to get a work visa in Belarus for citizens of Asian and African countries

Foreign citizens from Asian and African countries who wish to work in Belarus must obtain a work visa before starting work. The process includes several stages and preparation of special documents.

1. Job offer and work invitation

First, the candidate must receive an official job offer from a Belarusian employer. The employer is obliged to provide the candidate with a job application and provide a work invitation.

Only after receiving a work invitation can an employee apply for a visa.

2. Applying for a work visa.

After receiving a working invitation, the candidate can apply for a type C visa, which allows for a long stay in Belarus (more than 30 days). This visa can be extended as long as the person remains employed.

3. Required documents for obtaining a work visa

Applicants must prepare and submit the following documents to the Embassy or Consulate of Belarus in their country:

- Valid passport (must be valid for at least 90 days after the expected period of stay)
- Completed visa application form
- One recent passport-size photo (color)
- Original job invitation issued by a Belarusian employer
- An invitation letter from a Belarusian employer
- Medical insurance, valid in Belarus for the entire duration of your stay.
- Confirmation of the availability of financial resources (bank statement)
- Receipt of payment of the visa fee

4. Processing time and fees

The processing time usually takes 5-10 business days, depending on the embassy. Visa fees vary, but usually range from 60 to 120 USD. In some cases, an express service may be provided for an additional fee.

5. Arrival and check-in

Upon arrival in Belarus, foreign workers must register their place of residence within 10 days at the local migration office or online through a government portal.
